




Instructional Student Outcome and PLC Data

2022-2023 Student AT & PLC Outcome Data



Percentage of Direct Student Learning Skill Improvement Using AT

- 83.33% increase in independence in instructional activities
- 83.33% increase in active questioning and responding
- 44.44% increase in task completion
- 37.04% increase in access to grade level curriculum
- 42.59% increase in instructional engagement

Percentage of Communication Skill Improvement with AAC Systems

- 57.14% increased social competence and how to use AAC systems in social interactions
- 59.52% increased linguistic competence with the mastery of linguistic code
- 28.57% increased strategic competence using adaptive strategies to address deficits in multiple skill areas
- 19.05% increased interpersonal skills

Professional Learning Community Outcomes (Greatly Agree / Agree)

- 80% increased knowledge
- 91% meet the objectives
- 87% will use what was learned
- 84% will recommend training to others
- 88% this training will impact student outcomes

AT and UDL Loan Library

The AT & UDL Loan Library provides assistive technology devices for evaluations, assessments, and professional development. Loan library services include:

- Simple and complex assistive technologies for evaluations and assessments as required by IEPs and Florida Statute.
- Accessible educational devices, tools, and resources to support inclusion within the general classroom setting for all students with disabilities.
- Training devices, tools, and resources that are available to district/school staff and BEESS Discretionary Project staff.





One goal of an online system is to promote equitable service provision throughout Florida. The chart to the left illustrates service support in all Regions.



Professional Development Support

TLC Professional Development Services are designed to provide district and school staff multiple pathways to professional development (PD) hours and certifications.

Passport to Learning is an online micro-credential professional development program developed by the TLC Team and the Assistive Technology Industry Association. Participants can earn PD hours and Continuing Education Credits (CEUs).

Educators and Therapists from across Florida's school districts have applied for and participated in Passport activities.



RESNA Cohort is a two-year program that prepares participants for an Assistive Technology Professional (ATP) certification from the Rehabilitation Engineering and Assistive Technology Society of North America.

Environmental Communication Teaching (ECT) "Train-the-Trainer" is a year-long, team-based program targeting strategies to support students with complex communication needs.

AT in the Classroom provides training on assistive technology and integrated instructional strategies.
